PAST UNREAL CONDITIONS

• Look at these sentences:

• We use the third conditional to refer to past events. As with the second conditional the situations that we refer too are always unreal.

• To form the third conditional, use past perfect after if in the condition clause and a past modal (would, could, might) followed by have and a verb in past participle in the result clause.

• The verb wish can also be used with the third conditional form. In this case, we forget about the result clause and only use the condition clause. For example:

○ I *wish* I **had accepted** that offer.

○ Henry *wishes* he **had listened** to his friends' advice.

○ Logan *wishes* he **had saved** money while he had a job.

"Wish" (in the present tense) can be added to a sentence in the third conditional to express a more ideal result and past perfect verbs, again either positive or negative, accompany the subject of these sentences.
