**The decision**

I have refused your application for a visit visa because I am not satisfied that you meet the requirements of paragraph(s) V4.2-V4.10 of Appendix V: Immigration Rules for Visitors because:

- The onus is on you to qualify for entry clearance based on your own circumstances and your own intentions. You have said that your son in law will accommodate you whilst you are in the United Kingdom and I am satisfied that he is in a position to do so based on the documents provided and the interview that we conducted. While I take that into account in assessing your proposed maintenance and accommodation in the UK, this is only one aspect of the visitor rules and this sponsorship does not satisfy me of your own intention to leave the UK on completion of your visit.
- I am aware of the importance of this visit to you; however I am not satisfied that these outweigh my other concerns against the requirements of the Immigration Rules. I have considered the evidence provided and written statements you have made, but I am not satisfied you have met the requirements of the Immigration Rules on this occasion.
- In order to assess your intentions I must consider your circumstances in Pakistan based on the information you have provided with your application. All applicants are advised to provide documents to substantiate their circumstances. We expect applicants to provide this information as it assists us in making an informed assessment as to whether they intend to
